SohoPhotoGallery is pleased to announce the **12th Annual Alternative Processes Competition**. The gallery is New York City's longest running co-operative photography gallery. All selected photographs will be exhibited November 2-26, 2016.

WHAT IS ALTERNATIVE PROCESS?

Alternative processes include, but are not limited to: Albumen, Cyanotype, Van Dyke Brown, Platinum/Palladium, Gum Bichromate, Bromoil, Salt Print, Tintype, Ziatype, Daguerreotype, Image Transfers, Liquid Emulsion, Photogravure as well as handmade prints created from digital negatives. Traditional Silver Gelatin Prints, C-Prints and Digital Prints are not eligible. There is no limitation as to subject matter.

JUROR

Miriam Leuchter is Editor-in-Chief of Popular Photography and Editor-in-chief of American Photo Magazine. She serves on the board of The Josephine Herrick Project, a nonprofit that enlists photographic community volunteers to educate students who have not had the opportunity to learn the communicative power of photography. She has juried many international photography competitions, and her own work has been published and exhibited in magazines, newspapers, and art galleries in the United States and Europe.

SUBMISSION

The competition is open to all photographers age 18 years old and older, excluding members of Soho Photo Gallery. Digital entries and fees must be uploaded at [callforentry](http://callforentry.com) where you will find submission instructions.

1-5 IMAGES \$40 • 6-15 IMAGES \$5 each additional image

PRIZES

First, second and third place prizes will be awarded as well as two or more honorable mentions. Winners will be listed on our website: sohophoto.com.

WINNING PHOTOGRAPHS

Photographs must be suitably prepared for gallery presentation or will not be accepted. Maximum height or width (including frame) of exhibited work cannot exceed 48 inches. Packing and delivery instructions will be emailed to participants. Work must be wired for hanging.

COMMISSION AND INSURANCE

The Gallery's commission for the sale of prints is 30%. Although we will make reasonable efforts to protect your work while it is in our possession, we are not legally responsible for it. Consider insuring your work for the time it is in the gallery.
