New York, NY– Soho Photo Gallery begins 2008 with a guest exhibit, **Psychologists in Focus**. Come and peer into the psyches of eleven professional psychologists who risk exposing their subjective views of the world for everyone to see. The first show of its kind to bring together psychologists who are also dedicated photographers, *Psychologists in Focus* is one component of a larger project to examine the many points of contact that psychology and photography have shared for the past 150 years. Both photography and psychology have exerted profound influences on contemporary culture so come psyche out the shrinks and ponder the connections for yourself.

Coming also in January: a solo show by a Gallery member and a special members' group show.

**John F. Chang's** first show at Soho Photo is entitled **Through the Lens of a Dancer** and will include twelve 16 by 20 inch black-and-white prints. Chang, who was formerly a professional ballet dancer, says: "Ballet has always intrigued photographers; my many years on the stage have greatly enriched my understanding in this regard and contributed to my artistic creation. Although a ballet dancer's life on the stage is brief, photography has extended mine. I try to use every means available to express myself through my lens in the hope that my motionless photographs will capture the soul of dancers and turn a fleeting moment into an artistic eternity."

**Memories, Dreams and Reflections** is the title of January's special group show that will give Gallery members the opportunity to interpret this somewhat ambiguous theme in a variety of formats and mediums from traditional silver gelatin prints to alternate processes such as Polaroid transfers. Some members may even choose to use their Krappy Kameras<sup>sm</sup>. Their work promises to be very revealing and a unique test of the members' photographic skills, creativity and insight. At least eleven shrinks will be watching the results closely.
