SohoPhotoGallery is pleased to announce the **13th Annual Alternative Processes Competition**. The gallery is New York City's longest running co-operative photography gallery. All selected photographs will be exhibited October 4 – November 4, 2017.

WHAT IS ALTERNATIVE PROCESS?

Alternative processes include, but are not limited to: Albumen, Cyanotype, Van Dyke Brown, Platinum/Palladium, Gum Bichromate, Bromoil, Salt Print, Tintype, Ziatype, Daguerreotype, Image Transfers, Liquid Emulsion, Chemigram, Photogravure as well as handmade prints created from digital negatives. Traditional Silver Gelatin Prints, C-Prints and Digital Prints are not eligible. There is no limitation as to subject matter.

JUROR

Morgan Post is a Professor of Photography at Long Island and Fairfield Universities. He serves on the advisory board of The Penumbra Foundation in New York and teaches workshops across the eastern United States. In his photography he embraces 19th century techniques and uses antiquarian processes to experiment and innovate. His work has been exhibited and published nationally and internationally. Recent exhibitions include Art Intersection, El Laboratorio in Granada Spain, Art Space New Haven, and Vermont Center for Photography.

SUBMISSION

The competition is open to all photographers age 18 years old and older, excluding members of Soho Photo Gallery. Digital entries and fees must be uploaded at callforentry.org where you will find submission instructions.

FEES

1-5 IMAGES \$45 • 6-15 IMAGES \$5 each additional image

PRIZES

First, second and third place prizes will be awarded as well as two or more honorable mentions. Winners will be listed on our website: sohophoto.com.

WINNING PHOTOGRAPHS

Photographs must be suitably prepared for gallery presentation or will not be accepted. Maximum height or width (including frame) of exhibited work cannot exceed 48". Packing and delivery instructions will be emailed to participants. Work must be wired for hanging.

SohoPhoto Gallery shall receive a 30% commission for any sales. Every reasonable effort will be made to protect your work while it is in our possession, but we are not legally responsible for it. Consider insuring your work for the time it is in the gallery.
